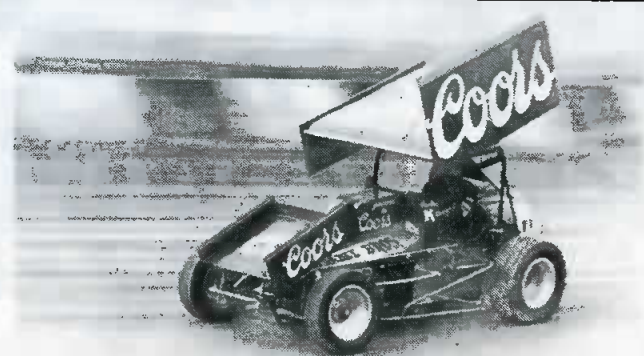

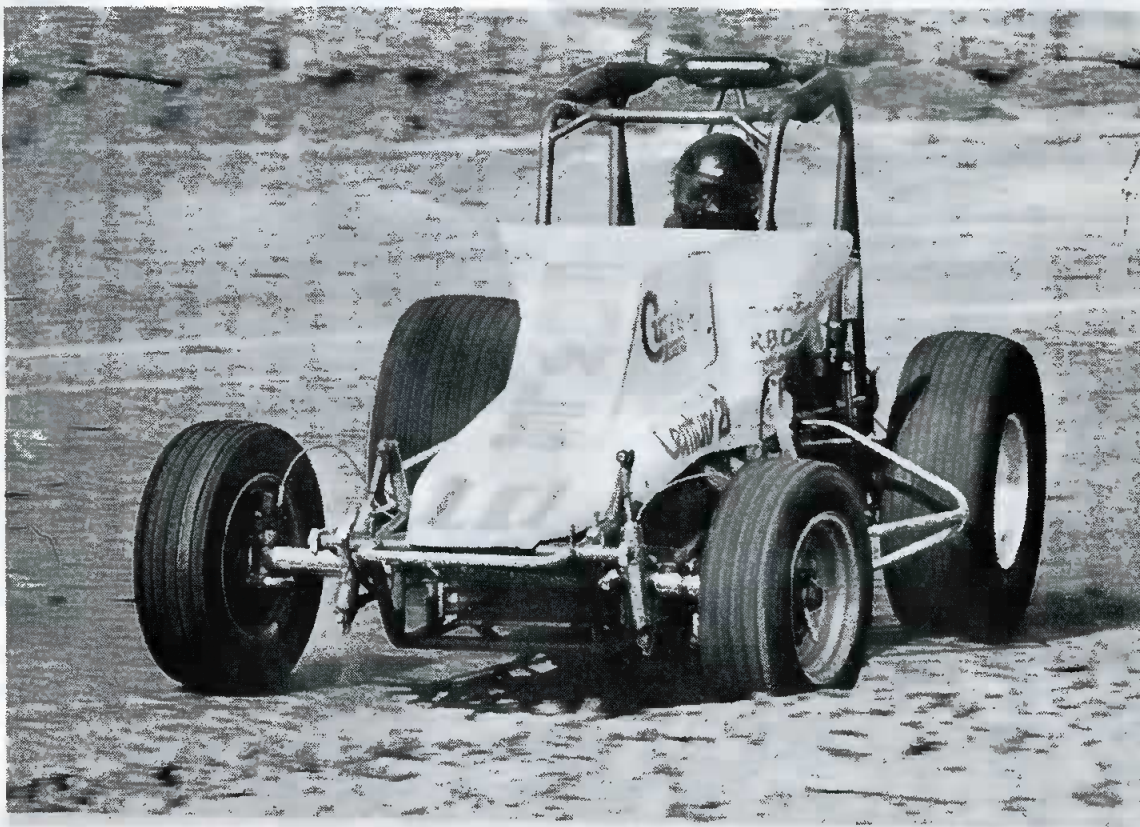
WEST COAST WANDERINGS **By: Don Gilchrest**

Is anyone going to stop Anaheim's Bubby Jones at Santa Maria Speedway? The transplanted mid-westerner has won four straight KRACO-CRA Championship Series feature events on Doug Fort's finely tuned 1/3 mile hard clay oval over the last two seasons. His latest victory came on May 8th in the first appearance of the C.R.A. sprint cars for 1982.

Not only is Jones hot at Santa Maria, but he has won eight feature events so far this season and is locked in a see-saw battle for the point lead in C.R.A. with the champion the last two years . . . Dean Thompson. Their battle is really a show stopper.

Since the May 8th appearance here at Santa Maria Speedway the KRACO-CRA Championship Series has run Ascot Park in Gardena five times with Thompson winning three features and Bubby Jones two. Two races at Speedway 117 in Chula Vista has found Clark Templeman and Ron Shuman feature winners and Tony Simon was a double winner in features at Manzanita Speedway in Phoenix, AZ.

This will be the 23rd race of the season for C.R.A. and the second of three races here at Santa Maria. This is the only track under a half mile that C.R.A. runs, so it is quite an equalizer. Right now Dean Thompson, Jimmy Oskie, Tony Simon, Duane Feduska, Eddie Wirth, Brad Noffsinger, Bob East, Rip Williams and the rest of C.R.A.'s top drivers are wondering when they are going to equal Bubby Jones here on the 1/3 mile. They all say tonight is the night!
